# Lay Rescuer Action Steps

Text in cascading boxes describes the steps to take action that a lay rescuer should perform in sequence to "Act Now. Save a Life." Arrows guide rescuers from one box to the next as they perform the actions. Some boxes have 2 arrows that lead outward, each to a different box depending on the outcome of the most recent action taken. Pathways are linked.

#### Box 1

# Unresponsive.

No breath, abnormal breathing (eg, gasping)

## Box 2

## Activate emergency response.

If possible, have another person proceed to <u>Box 3</u> while initial rescuer proceeds to <u>Box 4</u>.

#### Box 3

Get AED. Proceed to Box 5.

### Box 4

## Start CPR

• Press hard. Press fast in the center of the chest.

Continue until AED arrives, proceed to <u>Box 5</u>.

# Box 5

The AED arrives. Apply AED pads. Follow AED prompts. Resume CPR for 2 minutes.

Continue the cycle between Box 4 and Box 5.

If there's suspected opioid overdose, proceed to Box 6.

#### Box 6

If suspected opioid overdose, give a dose of naloxone (if available). Resume CPR (Box 4).
