The **American Heart Association Knowledge Booster** was created to reinforce critical CPR and emergency cardiovascular care information in an effort to save more lives. The AHA's *Resuscitation Education Scientific Statement* highlights the importance of spaced learning and use of innovative educational strategies during resuscitation training. Incorporating digital platforms and applying gamified learning can improve engagement and knowledge retention for students who have recently completed their AHA training.

Users can choose the topics appropriate for their level of knowledge – BLS, ACLS, PALS, and First Aid and CPR Basics. The quiz-based application features different types of questions from a wide range of topics depending on the disciplines you select, such as patient scenarios, CPR and defibrillation, rhythm identification, pharmacology, and other topics to test your knowledge. Users can access the AHA Knowledge Booster through the mobile app or browser.

WHO SHOULD USE THE APP?

This app is designed for students who have recently completed their AHA Provider course to help retain important concepts from the course. The app can also be used by AHA Providers to keep knowledge current when they are in between renewals for their AHA Course Completion Card.
