The **Advanced Life Support Modules** offer high-level topics beyond Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) content and provide Continuing Education (CE) credit.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

The AHA's ALS Modules are for advanced healthcare providers who seek additional content beyond ACLS. This includes personnel in emergency response and medicine, intensive care, and critical care units such as physicians, nurses, paramedics, and others.

COURSE COMPLETION

Due to the adaptive technology used in these modules, the completion time varies based on the student's self-assessment and knowledge of the cognitive material. The average time to complete is between 15 and 45 minutes.


COURSE DELIVERY
