

## Hands-Only CPR

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation



When you call 911, the dispatch operator will ask you a series of important questions that usually begin with, "What's your emergency?"

- BE CALM. Try to be patient as you answer questions about the person's condition. Let the operator know that you need to perform Hands-Only CPR. If you are unsure how to perform it at that moment, the operator can also walk you through it.
- KNOW YOUR LOCATION. The operator will need to know where you are. If you are in an unfamiliar place, take note of the address, nearby streets, or landmarks, and be ready to give the 911 operator as many details as possible.
- STAY ON THE LINE. Don't hang up until rescue arrives.

Calls to 911 are private and confidential.
